

Location: Rabbit Run Beagle Club is located approximately 10 minutes from Somerset in south central Kentucky. It is readily accessible by The interstate systems: I-75 and I-65 running north and south and I-64 and I-40 running east and west. It is also within minutes of the Cumberland Parkway (future Route 66) and many state route highway systems. It is also within minutes of beautiful Lake Cumberland, the largest water volume lake east of the Mississippi, with approximately 80,000 acres of water surface. Lake Cumberland is within minutes of the club and offers several campsites with full water and electrical hookups, marinas with boat rentals, restaurants, fishing, hunting, sightseeing, state city and county park systems, etc. Somerset is an excellent city with lots to offer including an ample variety lodging facilities, restaurants ranging from many fast foods to five star restaurants both in the city and on Lake Cumberland. The area is much more accessible to more beaglers than most other beagle clubs, especially for people in the Carolinas, the deep south, the northeast, Virginia and other areas to the north and west.

The Club will:

- o Provide 100 plus kennels for use by participants.
- o Provide two 30-acre enclosures with ample rabbits readily jumpable.
- o Reserve 13 bed and breakfast onsite lodging units at a rate of \$100 each for participants.
- o Provide 8 bunk beds onsite with bathrooms, showers and seating areas free of charge to judges and field marshalls.
- o Provide two mule type 4-wheelers (one for each enclosure) to transport dogs, judges and participants in the field during the event.
- o Provide food and cooks to prepare breakfast and lunch for each day of the event.
- o Provide field marshalls for the trial
- o Horse stables on adjoining farm.
