DRUGS OR SUPPLEMENTS FOR HOUNDS PARTICIPATING IN UBGF EVENTS, RULES PROPOSAL/MOTION

To ensure the complete integrity of the Beagle Sport, to provide for all participants a level playing field, to ensure all dogs placed based on their natural ability and to address concerns of participants. The following policies will be added to the UBGF Rules and Procedures;

- No supplement or drug can be given to any dog that has been determined by veterinary science to have adverse or negative effects on dogs.
- No supplement or drug can be given to any dog for the intent purpose of boosting energy and performance beyond the dogs' normal and natural ability.
- Supplements given to any dog for the purpose of hydration and maintaining endurance is allowed but must be presented to the Field Trial Committee for approval if questioned by a fellow participant. Any supplement given must be approved for use in dogs. Nothing injectable will be allowed. No supplement can be used during a series without approval of the Field Trial Committee.
- The Field Trial Committee can make determinations based on complaints by participants as to the negative impact or advantages a handler has achieved by administering dog supplements or drugs. The Field Trail Committee can disqualify a hound if determined to violate these rules.
